

FLAG DAY June 14

The American flag is a symbol of the country's history, pride and success in overcoming political oppression. Through its many incarnations and variations, the Stars and Stripes has waved over government buildings, schools and private residences.

According to History.com, in 1775, the Second Continental Army led to the creation of the first "American" flag. However, that flag was too similar to the British Union Jack flag, George Washington requested a revision. In 1777, the Second Continental Congress passed a resolution stating that the "flag of the United States be 13 stripes, alternate red and white." Furthermore, the "union" was represented by 13 stars of white in a blue field, "representing a new constellation."

More than a century later, a small-town Wisconsin teacher named Bernard Cigrand came up with the idea for an annual flag day in 1885. Even though the Fourth of July, a holiday in which the

flag is prominently and proudly displayed, had long been celebrated as the birthday of the United States, Cigrand wanted a holiday that would focus specifically on the flag in all its glory. June 14 was selected because it marked the anniversary of the official adoption of the first flag. Cigrand led his school in the first formal observance of the holiday, and throughout his life continued to advocate for respect of the flag.

Various other organizations liked the idea of a day to honor the flag, including the State Board of Education of New York, the Betsy Ross House and the New York Society of the Sons of the Revolution. Yet, it wasn't until May 30, 1916, that Flag Day was officially established by presidential proclamation by President Woodrow Wilson. Still, it would take another 33 years for President Truman to sign an Act of Congress designating June 14 as the official National Flag Day, which he did on August 3, 1949.

Americans can honor the flag by displaying it

on Flag Day. Here's how to display the flag properly, courtesy of Military.com.

Stamford, NY

• The flag should be free of any obstructions, such as power lines or tree limbs.

• If displayed with other flags, Old Glory should be at the top-most point or in the center of a horizontal array of flags.

• If the flag is displayed on its side, the blue field should be to the left.

• The flag should be raised in the morning at a residence or business and taken down at night. The only exception to the flag being out at night is if it's illuminated.

• Flags can be repaired. However, if a flag is tattered, it can be removed and brought to a local VFW hall to be properly disposed of.

Flag Day honors the Stars and Stripes, a symbol of the great American nation.

Melanin can help to block out harmful UV rays, which is why people with light skin tend to get sunburned while those with darker skin get tan after exposure to UV rays. However, melanin only helps to block out UV rays up to a certain point, so even people whose skin tans after UV ray exposure can be



Enjoy stuffed burgers this barbecue season

Barbecue season has arrived, so soon people will be bonding in the backyard over hamburgers and hot dogs. Backyard barbecue season begins in spring and continues through summer and, where the weather allows, into fall. Barbecues are a perfect summertime soiree, as they're usually laid back affairs and make use of the pleasant weather.

While it's fun to expand your culinary horizons over the open flame of a grill, it's important that you never forget the basics, especially when entertaining crowds who are no doubt looking forward to grilled burgers. Giving the masses what they want is good hosting, but you can still try your hand at a little experimentation when serving burgers at your next backyard barbecue. The following recipe for

mix the beef, garlic, salt, and pepper in a bowl until well blended; do not overmix. Using a light touch, form into 12 patties no more than 1/2-inch thick.

3. Put a portion (about 11/2 teaspoons) of cream cheese in the center of each of the 6 patties; top with the remaining patties and press together, taking care to seal the edges well. Refrigerate the burgers until the grill is ready.

4. Brush the grill grate and coat it with oil. Put the burgers on the grill, cover and cook for 9 minutes, flipping after 5 minutes, for medium-do-



ne (150 F, slightly pink). Add a minute per side for well-done (160 F).

5. To toast the buns, put them cut-sides down directly over the fire for the last minute of cooking.

6. If serving the burgers directly from the grill, serve on the buns. If the burgers will sit, even for a few minutes, keep the buns and burgers separate until just before eating.

Air conditioner buying guide

Window air conditioning units help people who do not have a central cooling system stay cool when temperatures rise.

When shopping for window air conditioners, consumers will no doubt encounter the acronym BTU. BTU stands for British Thermal Unit, which is a traditional measure-

ment of heat, defined as the amount of heat required to raise the temperature of one pound of water by one degree Fahrenheit at sea level. While BTUs may make sense when determining heat output of gas grills or the warming capacity of a heating appliance, just what do heating

units have to do with air conditioners?

According to Compact Appliance, when BTUs are used in relation to air conditioning systems, the measurement expresses how many BTUs can be removed from the air per hour, essentially reflecting how well heat can be extracted from a room and cooled by the unit.

While it may seem like having the highest BTU rating would always be ideal, this isn't always the

case. Cooling a room too quickly with an oversized unit may result in the appliance having to cycle on and off frequently, eventually overworking the air conditioner's compressor and potentially shortening its life span.

Similarly, using a unit that doesn't have enough BTUs will prevent the air conditioner from making a room comfortable, potentially compelling users to run the appliance in excess.

Instead, consumers

need to find the right unit for their needs. Measuring the square footage of a room and then comparing it against BTU guidelines for particular air conditioner units is a great way to ensure you find the right window unit. According to the home improvement experts at Lowes, the following are the advised BTU ratings matched up with room sizes:

• 150 to 350 sq. ft.: 5,000 to 8,000 BTUs

• 350 to 550 sq. ft.:

8.000 to 12.000 BTUs • 550 to 1,050 sq. ft.: 12,000 to 18,500 BTUs

• 1,050 to 1,600 sq. ft.: 18,500 to 25,000 BTUs.

Other factors will influence cooling capability as well. Consider whether a room gets a lot of sun or shade, and then adjust the BTU rating accordingly. Second-story rooms may have more ambient heat. Also, the number of occupants in a room may drive up the temperature, which may require purchasing a large unit.
