USDA Designates 17 New York Counties as Primary Natural Disaster Areas

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) designated 17 New York counties as primary natural disaster areas. Producers in who suffered losses caused by recent natural disasters may be eligible for USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) emergency loans.

These natural disaster designations allow FSA to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters. Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation or the refinance of certain debts.

Freeze and Frost – April - June 2020

Producers in Broome, Cattaraugus, Cayuga, Cortland, Niagara, Ontario, Oswego, Schuyler, Seneca, Tompkins and Wayne counties who suffered losses caused by freeze and frost that occurred April 1 through June 1, 2020, may be eligible for emergency loans.

Producers in the contiguous counties listed below are also eligible to apply for emergency loans:

- New York: Allegany, Chautauqua, Chemung, Chenango, Delaware, Erie, Genesee, Jefferson, Lewis, Livingston, Madison, Monroe, Oneida, Onondaga, Orleans, Steuben, Tioga, Wyoming and Yates
- Pennsylvania: McKean, Susquehanna, Warren and Wayne

Freeze

Producers in Jefferson, Onondaga, Orleans, Steuben and Yates counties who suffered losses caused by freeze that occurred April 15 through June 1, 2020, may be eligible for emergency loans.

Producers in the contiguous counties listed below are also eligible to apply for emergency loans:

- New York: Allegany, Cayuga, Chemung, Cortland, Genesee, Lewis, Livingston, Madison, Monroe, Niagara, Ontario, Oswego, St. Lawrence, Schuyler and Seneca
- Pennsylvania: Potter and Tioga

Frost

Producers in Erie County who suffered losses due to frost that occurred May 8 through May 9, 2020, may be eligible for emergency loans.

Producers in the contiguous New York counties of Cattaraugus, Genesee, Niagara and Wyoming are also eligible to apply for emergency loans.

The deadline to apply for emergency loans under this designation is Sept. 15, 2021.

FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability. FSA has a variety of additional programs to help farmers recover from the impacts of this disaster. FSA programs that do not require a disaster declaration include: Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees and Farm-Raised Fish Program;

Emergency Conservation Program; Livestock Forage Disaster Program; Livestock Indemnity Program; Operating and Farm Ownership Loans; and the Tree Assistance Program.

Farmers may contact their local USDA service center for further information on eligibility requirements and application procedures for these and other programs. Additional information is also available online at farmers. gov/recover.

Two of Delgado Veterans' Bills Signed Into Law

President Trump signed a comprehensive veterans' benefit package, H.R. 7105, into law Wednesday, Jan. 6. that incorporates the text of Rep. Delgado's bipartisan Fairness for Local Veteran Cemeteries Act and Improving Benefits for Underserved Veterans Act. H.R. 7105 passed the Senate on Dec. 9, 2020 and passed the House of Representatives on Dec. 16, 2020. Included in the law is Delgado's bill to ensure counties in states without a state-run national cemetery, including New York, can access federal funds to establish, expand, or improve a county-run veteran cemetery. The law also includes the Delgado-led bill to require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to publish a report on veteran's benefits, disaggregated by sex and minority group mem-

"I am very glad to see the President has signed H.R. 7105 into law, which includes two of my bills. This new law will ultimately support our nation's veterans, ensuring equality of access to benefits, and protecting their final resting place. Both of these measures reflect the needs and concerns of our

ber status.

upstate veterans. The idea behind the Fairness for **Local Veteran Cemeteries** Act stemmed from my first bipartisan, locally-based Veterans Advisory Committee meeting. Captain Steve Massee, former Director of the Ulster County Veterans Service Agency, highlighted a technical error that prevented Ulster County, and other counties in New York, from accessing federal funding for its veteran cemeteries. Based on this feedback, I introduced the Fairness for Local Veteran Cemeteries Act," said Representative Antonio Delgado. "Additionally, I introduced the Improving Benefits for Underserved Veterans Act after visiting facilities serving women veterans in upstate New York. The report on veteran benefits disaggregated by sex and minority group member status will help us to understand and address the gaps in care for women and minority veterans. This new law helps us provide the quality care and support our veterans

"My sincere thanks to Congressman Delgado for his role in passage of the Fairness for Local Veteran Cemeteries Act. It removes

a statutory barrier to federal VA funding of local veteran cemetery construction, and thereby makes possible such funding for Ulster County's badly needed Veteran Cemetery expansion in New Paltz. I look forward to the Congressman's continued work in this area, to ensure that the State of New York provides the necessary endorsement of Ulster County's application for VA cemetery construction funding." said Steve Massee, Retired Director, Ulster **County Veteran Services**

"I'd like to thank Congressman Delgado and everyone on his Veterans Advisory Committee who helped develop these bills and continues to work to support our veterans. The Fairness for Local Veteran Cemeteries Act will ensure our local veteran cemeteries can access needed federal support - an especially important issue here in NY, where many of our veteran cemeteries are countymanaged. Additionally, the Improving Benefits for Underserved Veterans Act will help the VA develop a better understanding of the unique needs of female and minority veterans, so it can make informed investments to better serve all veteran communities. With female veterans being the fastest growing subgroup of veterans and the fastest growing group of homeless veterans, we must make sure our government can address all veterans' needs, such as access to women's health care or homeless shelters." said Malia Du Mont, Chair of Rep. Delgado's NY-19 Advisory Committee on Veterans.

Rep. Delgado, along with Reps. Don Young, (AK-AL), Elise Stefanik (NY-21), and Brian Mast (FL-18), introduced the Fairness for Local Veteran Cemeteries Act. There are currently four states whose veteran cemeteries are run by individual counties or county-equivalents: New York, Florida, Alaska, and Oregon. Rep. Delgado's bill ensures that counties in these states are eligible for grants to cover the maintenance and operation costs of veteran cemeteries. In June 2020, Rep. Delgado testified in support of the Fairness for Local Veteran Cemeteries Act before the House Committee on Veterans' Affairs. On December 16, 2020, Rep. Delgado spoke in support of H.R. 7105, which includes the

Fairness for Local Veteran Cemeteries Act.

Rep. Delgado introduced the Improving Benefits for Underserved Veterans Act, which would direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to publish a report on veterans' benefits disaggregated by sex and minority group member status. This report would provide the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and Congress with the necessary data to better educate those veterans on their entitled benefits and address any disparities in coverage and benefit usage amongst those groups. On October 22, 2019, the Congressman spoke before the House Veterans' Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs about his legislation, the Improving Benefits for Underserved Veterans Act. On December 16, 2020, Rep. Delgado spoke in support of H.R. 7105, which includes the Improving Benefits for Underserved Veterans Act.




