



Del Co Announces COVID-19 Vaccination Information

The Delaware County Board of Supervisors announced that they are working with New York state, local health care providers and local pharmacies to administer as many COVID-19 vaccinations each week as they can.

Each authorized group that can provide vaccinations receives a limited supply of vaccine each week. To date, Delaware County Public Health has vaccinated 613 people and will continue to vaccinate 1B essential workers. Beginning the week of Feb. 15, public health will also be vaccinating people 65 and older with comorbidities. People over the age 65 can call the Delaware County Office for the Aging at 607-832-5750 to schedule an appointment at a Public Health Clinic. Vaccines will also continue to be available for people over 65 at pharmacies and state mass vaccination sites.

Hospitals and state run mass vaccination sites are also accepting appointments for individuals with comorbidities beginning Feb. 15. Pharmacies have been designated to vaccinate residents 65 and older throughout the country. They are distributed directly to the pharmacies from the federal government and are not included in the state distribution plan. CVS in Margaretville, and Walgreens in Sidney, Delhi and Stamford are all registered vaccination sites. To schedule an appointment, visit cvs.com or Walgreens.com to set up an account and register for an appointment.

Currently there are no state run vaccination sites located in Delaware County, with the closest ones being located at SUNY Binghamton or SUNY Albany. People must register for appointments at these sites through the NYS DOH webpage https://am-ieligible.covid19vaccine. health.ny.gov/.

The Delaware County BOS is encouraging every eligible Delaware County resident to seek an appointment to get vaccinated. They are also speaking with state and federal representatives on a regular basis expressing the need for vaccine in Delaware County to accommodate the population.

"We are committed to getting Delaware County fully reopened and back to some level of normalcy," BOS Chairwoman Tina Molé stated. "In the meantime please keep wearing face coverings when in public, practice social distancing and prepare to get vaccinated once you are eligible."



Industries hiring during the pandemic

The COVID-19 pandemic has had a devastating impact on the world. Data from Worldometer, which analyzes, validates and aggregates COVID-19 figures from around the globe, indicates that, by early February 2021, the virus had claimed more than 2.3 million lives and infected nearly 108 million people since it first began to spread in late 2019.

The human toll of the virus has been devastating, and many people also have felt the economic impact of the pandemic. It's difficult to determine a global unemployment rate, but sources including the International Monetary Fund and the World Economic Outlook Database have estimated that the unemployment rate in the United States by October 2020 was more than 5 percent higher than it was at the end of 2019. In Canada, the unemployment rate had reached 9.7 percent by October, which marked a roughly 4 percent increase compared to the end of 2019.

Though many people who lost their jobs during

the pandemic remain out of work, certain industries have grown during the pandemic.

• Health care: The health care industry has been stretched thin during the pandemic, and that's led to increased opportunities. In addition, industry forecasters have long pointed to a potential nursing shortage in the years to come. For example, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics estimates that as many as two million nurses are expected to retire by 2022. Those figures should lead to even more opportunities in a profession that is already facing a shortage of qualified candidates.

• Technology: Many businesses transitioned to remote work during the pandemic, and that's created opportunities for skilled technology professionals capable of facilitating such transitions. Recruiting industry professionals note that such positions may be offered on a contractonly basis, particularly by companies that ultimately want to return to in-office work after the pandemic has ended. However, some

companies have extended their work-from-home policies into fall 2021, and some, including Google, have announced plans to support remote work indefinitely. So demand for skilled technology workers capable of helping companies run remotely could very well continue even after the economy has recovered from the pandemic.

• E-commerce: The ecommerce industry did not need the pandemic to give it a boost. But e-commerce has certainly been relied on more heavily in the wake of social distancing restrictions and overall consumer hesitancy about in person shopping. Professionals with experience in web development and e-commerce may find their skills are in need, while online retailers like Amazon may be in need of workers to help with fulfillment and logistics.

Though the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic has been devastating, various industries have a need for qualified professionals.

Floodway Encroachment and No-Rise Certification Workshop a Success

New landowners may not be aware that before any new structures can be built in floodways, they must prove there will be no resulting rise in flood elevations. Anyone looking to build in a floodway must provide local building departments with plans and engineering models that prove no rise will occur. Without this, the project cannot move forward.

Floodways are the por-

James Woidt of J.L. Woidt Engineering, one of several consultants who delivered the program, said that "The regulatory floodway is the portion of a watercourse that FEMA has mapped as conveying the most flood water. As small changes within the floodway could result in large increases in flood depths, proper management of the floodway is critical to mangrounds in engineering and floodplain management. "We were pleased to have supported CCEUC with presenting a workshop on this important topic to help local communities understand the real-world application of local floodway regulations and provide practical tools to help communities manage development proposed within the floodway," said Woidt

tion of floodplains closest to streams and contain swifter, deeper, and more dangerous flows during a flood. When streams are at low flow, floodways appear to be attractive areas for building or living – who doesn't want to hear a babbling brook from their patio? Yet floodways can be deadly and dangerous during high flows, or at minimum the site of significant and costly property damage. Generally, builders and landowners are advised to avoid putting structures in floodways. However, some are willing to risk it and local building departments do receive applications for construction in floodways.

The Ashokan Watershed Stream Management Program (AWSMP) recently hosted a successful threeday workshop on the topic of Floodway Encroachment and No-Rise Certifications. The workshop was held entirely online over three separate weeks in February and was attended by 54 local municipal officials, engineers, and agency representatives. Code enforcement officers, certified floodplain managers, and professional engineers received continuing education credit for attendance.

aging flood damages in the community,"

Local Code Enforcement Officers and other officials learned more about federal regulations that require engineering analyses demonstrating new construction will not result in a rise in flood elevations. The workshop's goal was to help local officials and engineers better understand the oftencomplex engineering involved and how to properly review reports for accuracy.

Throughout the workshop, discussion centered around the need to thoroughly review project proposals and determine if the location was really the best place for a structure. Floodways are by their nature typically the most dangerous areas of the SFHA and where most of the destruction occurs during a flood. While technically feasible, instructors emphasized it is imperative that communities review each application and ensure these projects align with community plans.

riodic technical trainings on stream and floodplain management topics every year. DEC Announces Online Falconry, Wildlife Rehabilitator, and Leashed Tracking Dog Exams

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) announced that examinations for individuals seeking a license to practice the sport of falconry, become a volunteer wildlife rehabilitator, or use leashed tracking dogs to find wounded or injured big game animals are scheduled for Friday, April 30.

To ensure access to the examinations, and prevent the spread of COVID-19, DEC is offering exams online this year instead of in-person. The exams will be available from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. on April 30. Registrants will have two hours to take each exam.

To register for any of these exams, click on the exam registration link and follow out the world and requires a significant commitment of time and effort. Apprentices are limited to possessing one bird, either an American kestrel or a red-tailed hawk. A falconry study guide and examination manual are available on the DEC website at no cost. The cost of a five-year falconry license is \$40.

To qualify for the Apprentice Falconry license, applicants must: • score 80 percent or high-

er on the written exam; • be at least 14

years of age; • possess a valid New York State hunting license; and

• maintain DEC-approved facilities for housing falcon-ry raptors.

mals to the wild. Prospective applicants are encouraged to gain experience by serving as an assistant to a licensed wildlife rehabilitator. A wildlife rehabilitator study guide and examination manual are available on the DEC website at no cost. There is no cost for the five-year wildlife rehabilitation license.

To qualify for the Wildlife Rehabilitator License, applicants must:

• score 80 percent or higher on the written exam;

• be at least 16 years of age; and

• be interviewed by DEC regional wildlife staff.





House Passes Rep. Delgado-Backed Bipartisan VA VACCINE Act

Here in the New York's 19th Congressional District. it will make a potentially lifesaving difference for tens of thousands of veterans. As a veteran myself, I'm grateful for Congressman Delgado's continued leadership on these issues - he has prioritized supporting veterans from day one of being in office."
