Protect Your Home (And More) From Winter's Freeze



Freezing temperatures may be good for ice skating or building snowmen, but sub-freezing temperatures can be dangerous for the average person and his or her home.

Cold weather often leaves people scurrying to do whatever is necessary to safeguard themselves from the big chill. But it's important homeowners also protect their homes in cold weather.

**Plumbing**  
Plumbing and pipes may be vulnerable to cold weather. Frozen pipes may burst and cause substantial damage to a home, potentially causing flooding and structural damage.

Homeowners should disconnect and drain garden hoses before winter arrives. Water to outdoor hose bibs should be turned off, though the valves on these outdoor faucets should be left open to

drain. Also, outdoor faucets can be covered with insulating foam covers.

The Red Cross says pipes that freeze most frequently include pipes in unheated areas, such as basements, attics, garages, and crawl spaces. Close vents to the outside in areas like attics and basements to limit the amount of cold air that gets indoors. Think about insulating unheated areas, as well as using pipe sleeves, heat tape or wraps on exposed pipes.

By opening kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors, homeowners can allow warm air from a home to reach pipes under the sink. During extreme freezes, keep cold water dripping from a sink to prevent pipes from freezing.

**Service HVAC systems**  
It's important to ensure that heating systems are working properly prior to the cold-weather season. It

may only take hours for the interior of a home to reach dangerously low temperatures without adequate heat. Homeowners should schedule annual checkups of furnaces and hot water heaters. Inspect the heat exchanger for cracks, install a clean air filter and make sure all thermostats are working properly.

**Have fuel ready**  
Homeowners who heat their homes with oil, wood or coal should make sure they have plenty of fuel on hand in advance of winter. Shortages can occur, and it may take some time for new fuel to arrive in the midst of a cold snap.

As a precaution, homeowners can rely on portable space heaters to fill in the heating gaps during freezing temperatures. Exercise extreme caution with these devices, turning them off when leaving the room and remembering to

avoid overloading outlets.

**Protect outside**  
Drain birdbaths, clean out downspouts and remove water from other items where water can freeze and cause damage. Inspect roofing prior to the snowy season, but stay off roofs during freezing weather.

Remove snow shovels and other winter gear from storage and make sure the items are easily accessible during snowstorms.

Winter's bite can be severe. Homeowners can protect themselves and their properties when the freeze sets in.

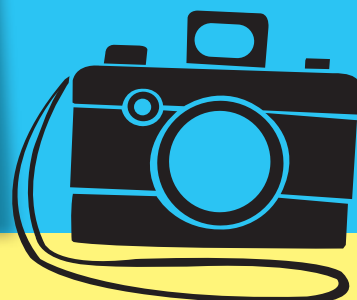

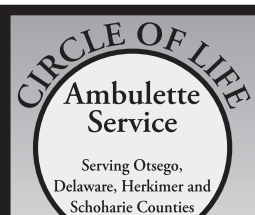

## 2022 Grant Funding Available From DelCo Tourism Advisory Board

The Delaware County Tourism Advisory Board (TAB) is accepting applications for funding under the 2022 Tourism Promotion & Development Grant program. This program will provide funding assistance to eligible applicants for projects that seek to attract visitors to Delaware County and enhance the overall tourism industry. Applications for grant assistance under must be hand-delivered to the Delaware County Department of Economic Development or postmarked by 5 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 25. Emails will not be accepted.

The Tourism Promotion & Development Grant program is funded through revenue raised through the Delaware County Occupancy Tax. An occupancy tax was implemented to create dedicated funding to promote and develop the tourism industry within Delaware County and to stimulate economic growth. Since 2017, funds raised through the occupancy tax have supported 197 projects that promote and increase tourism in Delaware County. Projects that have received support through this initiative include improving signage for hiking trails, renovations to historic properties, local and regional marketing activities, the development of promotional materials and support for artistic, cultural and community events that seek to attract visitors to Delaware County, and other projects seeking to grow the tourism industry.

In 2022, the Tourism Promotion & Development Grant Program will again focus on five categories of awards: Promotion/Marketing, Community Celebrations, Capital Improvements, Arts & Culture and Major Capital Improvements.

**Promotion/Marketing:** Projects should promote specific locales, activities, groups of businesses or tourism segments in Delaware County and target a defined market of non-county visitors. In general, funds requested under this category should be used to cover costs related to printed materials, website and social media marketing, and other promotional or marketing initiatives. The maximum amount of funding available under this category is \$5,000.

**Community Celebrations:** Projects that support events, programs, or a series of events that seek to build upon historical, musical, culinary, agricultural, recreational and/or cultural traditions of the area and hold the reasonable potential to attract non-county visitors. Events must be open to the general public. Community Celebrations limited to serving the local community without a strategy for growth or not seeking to attract non-county visitors will not be funded. The maximum amount of funding available under this category is \$1,200.

**Capital Improvements:** Projects eligible for funding under this category include the renovation/construction of tourism properties owned by a municipality or non-profit, infrastructure improvements with a direct relationship to tourism, and other physical/structural items with a greater than 5-year lifespan. The maximum amount of funding available under this category is \$5,000.

**Arts & Culture:** Projects that support artistic events, programs, or a series of events that seek to promote public engagement and access to the arts and hold the reasonable potential to attract non-county visitors. Events must be open to the general public. Artistic events/programs limited to serving the local community without a strategy for growth, or not seeking to attract non-county visitors will not be funded. The maximum amount of funding available under this category is \$1,200.

**Major Capital Improvements:** For the second straight year, the Tourism Promotion & Development Grant Program will also include a fifth category of award for Major Capital Improvement projects, providing for grants of up to \$25,000. While the criteria will be similar to that for capital projects, this category is reserved for one or two large scale capital improvement projects designed to have a significant impact on the tourism industry in Delaware County.

Municipalities, non-profit corporations and certain not-for-profit entities are eligible for funding. For-profit businesses are no longer eligible to apply under fiscal sponsorship of a municipality or non-profit organization. Instead, the Tourism Advisory Board expects to announce a new for-profit tourism grant program later this winter. All grants will be awarded on a competitive basis and will require a minimum 1:1 cash match.

Entities that were approved for funding in 2020 but were forced to delay the implementation of their project due to the COVID-19 pandemic, are not required to submit a new application for funding for their project. They should instead contact Kelly Mariotti to discuss any modifications to their original project and new timeframe.

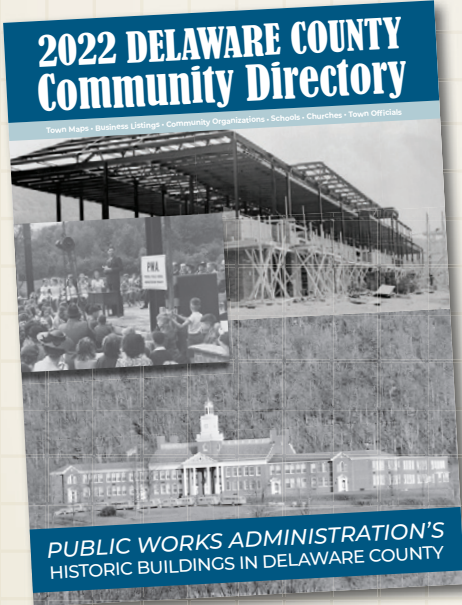

### Love Our New York Lands By Responsibly Enjoying Winter Recreation

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) reminds visitors to practice Leave No Trace™ while recreating on state lands this winter. We all have a responsibility to protect State lands for future generations. Following the Seven Principles of Leave No Trace, set forth by the Leave No Trace Center for Outdoor Ethics, is one way users are encouraged to Love Our NY Lands.

The Leave No Trace™ Seven Principles provide helpful guidance to reduce your impact on the environment and keep yourself and those around you safe.

**Plan ahead and prepare.** Proper planning is vital to ensure a safe winter adventure. Visitors should know their limits, set realistic goals, and choose an appropriate experience. Outdoor adventurers are encouraged to research trails and routes before setting out and contact DEC or other knowledgeable parties with questions.

**Winter weather can change rapidly.** Prepare for every occasion by bringing the 10 Hike Smart NY essentials, including food, water, navigation, warm layers, snowshoes and traction devices, a headlamp, first-aid kit, and matches or a lighter. Stay up to date with current weather reports and if the forecast calls for harsh conditions, consider rescheduling.

**Make a timeline, including a turnaround time, and stick to it.** Visitors should leave their trip plans with a trusted friend or relative that will call for help if they don't return on time. For more tips on preparing for a safe outdoor winter experience, visit DEC's winter hiking safety page.

**Travel and camp on durable surfaces.** Travel on durable surfaces to help maintain the integrity of trails and limit damage to trailside vegetation. Snow is considered a durable surface once it is six inches deep. Snowshoes make walking in deep snow easier and help prevent postholing, the act of creating deep holes in the snow with bare boots. Use traction devices, such as crampons or microspikes, to travel safely across ice.

**Properly dispose of waste.** Visitors to state lands are asked to carry out what they carry in, including garbage, food scraps, broken gear, and pet waste. Dispose of trash in a designated can at the trailhead or at home. Go before you go and use toilets or out-houses whenever possible. Visitors should also be prepared to dig a cat hole or pack out poop where toilets aren't available.

**Leave what you find.** Leave trail signs and markers so others can find their way, and leave historic artifacts and natural features for others to enjoy. Do not carve or graffiti rocks, trees, or backcountry structures.

**Minimize campfire impacts.** Visitors should use designated fireplaces whenever possible and only burn dead and downed wood. When finished with the fire, extinguish it completely. Never leave a fire unattended or build a fire inside a structure such as a lean to or tent.

**Respect wildlife.** Never follow, approach, or feed wildlife. Human food can harm wildlife and feeding wildlife can create bad habits that lead to unwanted human interaction and habituation.

**Be considerate of other visitors.** Help all visitors have a safe and enjoyable experience by following winter trail etiquette. Wear snowshoes or skis on snowy trails to avoid post-holing. Separate ski and snowshoe tracks when possible. Yield to downhill skiers and move to the side of the trail to let snowmobiles pass. Snowmobile riders are reminded to slow down when passing pedestrians.

DEC's 'Love Our New York Lands' campaign was launched in response to the steady increase in the number of visitors to state lands, both during the COVID-19 pandemic and in the decade prior, as more and more New Yorkers and visitors from other states and countries discovered the natural beauty of New York state. ### NYSPHSAA Announces It Will Be Subject To NYSDOH Guidelines Requiring Vaccinations Or Negative Test For Large-Scale Events

LATHAM, NY - The New York State Public High School Athletic Association (NYSPHSAA) has announced it will be subject to the New York State Department of Health guidance for large-scale indoor events for two of its state tournaments—the Wrestling Individual Championships and the Boys Basketball Championships—in which all attendees ages 5 and older will be

required to show proof of full vaccination or a negative test upon entry into the venue. In accordance with NYSDOH, the guidance is “in effect for large-scale indoor events of 5,000 attendees or greater.”

Annually, NYSPHSAA sees over 5,000 spectators, coaches, athletes, volunteers, committee members and staff attend the Wrestling Individual Championships and the Boys Basketball Championships each day they are held. The Association anticipates easily exceeding 5,000 attendees each day of each event again this year and therefore will be subject to the guidance.

Per NYSDOH guidance, all attendees ages five and older (including coaches and athletes) at the Wrestling Championships, held on February 25-26 at MVP Arena in Albany, and the Boys Basketball Championships, held on March 18-20 at Cool Insuring Arena in Glens Falls, will be required to show proof of full vaccination at the turnstiles of each venue or a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours of the event. NYSPHSAA is working with both venues in an effort to offer on-site testing and additional details will be made available when finalized.

According to NYSDOH guidelines, full vaccination is defined as having received the second mRNA vaccine shot (or single Johnson & Johnson dose) at least 14 days prior to the start of each tournament. Proof must be provided in paper form, digitally, or by presenting the State's Excelsior Pass. In accordance with the September 2nd NYSDOH guidance related to scholastic events, masks are required to be worn at all times when inside either venue.

“As the governing body for interscholastic athletics in New York state, it is important that we adhere to NYSDOH guidelines that are in place for the health and safety of participants and fans,” said Dr. Robert Zayas, NYSPHSAA Executive Director. “A year ago, hosting state championship events was not possible. Thankfully, we now have the ability to provide participation opportunities for students under the direction of public health officials.”

On December 7th, NYSPHSAA notified its membership it would adhere to vaccination requirements set forth by Rochester Institute of Technology which is hosting the NYSPHSAA Competitive Cheerleading Championships on March 5th. All attendees of this event, ages five and older, will be required to show proof of full vaccination upon entry into the venue. The University policy was set forth for events with 400 or more attendees and does not allow for proof of negative test.

Additionally, New York City Parks and Recreation is requiring spectators, ages five and older, to show proof of full vaccination if they plan to attend the NYSPHSAA Indoor Track State Championships at Ocean Breeze Athletic Complex on March 5th.

On September 9th, NYSPHSAA adopted a Championship Protocol policy which states it will “honor and abide by all terms, conditions and restrictions imposed by the scheduled and contracted venue for matters impacting and protecting public health.”
